Description The works by Thomas Huber kept in the Kunsthaus are part of a group of works he produced from 1989 to 1992 and presented in Utrecht, Hanover and at the Kunsthaus Zürich in 1992/93 under the title 'The Scent of Money - The Bank. A conception of value'. The 'Bank' summarises the various elements that - inspired by alchemy - evoke the transformation of money into soap.
